2) Author Information:

Include the full names, affiliations, and contact details of all authors.

Clearly identify the corresponding author.

3) Formatting:

Chapters should be written in a standard academic format with a clear structure, including introduction, methodology, results, discussion, and conclusion.

4) Length:

Chapter should be 10-25 pages.

5) Figures and Tables:

Clearly label all figures and tables.
